2018 National Officer Candidate Selection Process Timeline

MARCH 1, 2018

- Email Letter of Application and Resume to Office of Agricultural Education at ag.ed.registration@ag.nj.gov. Follow the guidelines listed in the National Officer Selection Process Handbook - https://www.ffa.org/SiteCollectionDocuments/nationalofficer_selection_process_handbook.pdf

MARCH 15, 2018

- American FFA Degree Applications Due

MAY 1, 2018

- Email "What do you hope to accomplish as a national officer?" essay (1,000 words or less) and SAE program description per year (200 characters or less per year) Office of Agricultural Education at ag.ed.registration@ag.nj.gov.

MAY 25, 2018

- Introduction of New Jersey's National Officer Candidate(s) at Convention Session IV (7:30pm)

JUNE 1, 2018

- Email completed National Officer Candidate Development Form to Office of Agricultural Education at ag.ed.registration@ag.nj.gov. This form can be found on the State Activity Guide.

JUNE 9 OR 10, 2018

- Facilitate workshop at State Officer Leadership Training

JUNE 14, 2018 (Tentative)

- National Officer Candidate Selection Process

9:00 am – 5:00 pm (all phases of the process will be evaluated)
