



New Jersey State FFA Leadership Grant
Offered by the New Jersey FFA Alumni Association
Through the New Jersey FFA Foundation, Inc.



Grant Purpose:

- To provide leadership opportunities to FFA members and local chapters
- To encourage new FFA Alumni Affiliates
- To increase the partnership between local and state FFA Alumni
- To build a network of FFA supporters

Grant Eligibility:

- Any FFA chapter in good standing can apply for the grant
- One grant application per chapter
- Each chapter can submit materials for up to two levels as described below

Grant Requirements:

- All materials must be submitted by February 1, 2011
- Level 1 must be completed before the chapter is eligible for Level 2 or 3
- All materials, as outlined on page two of this application, must be submitted
- All requested signatures, as outlined on page two of this application, must be provided

Level 1: Golf Tournament Sponsor

(Must complete this level before advancing to Level 2a or Level 2b)

If a chapter raises at least \$150 for the NJ FFA Alumni Golf Tournament (through tee sign sponsorships), the NJ FFA Alumni will provide one FREE student state convention registration. (Golf Tournament sponsor(s) will receive a tee sign.) In the end, a chapter that participates in this level will receive two student state convention registrations (one from the Golf Tournament sponsorship and one from the NJ State Alumni).

-AND-

Level 2a: Alumni Affiliate

If the chapter has an active Alumni Affiliate, the NJ FFA Alumni will provide one FREE student state convention registration. The Affiliate must submit requested materials and hold two meetings by the application deadline. In the end, a chapter that participates in this level will receive three student state convention registrations (one from the Golf Tournament sponsorship and one from the NJ State Alumni in level 1 and one for having an active Alumni Affiliate).

-OR-

Level 2b: New Alumni Affiliate

If a chapter charters (or re-activates) an Alumni Affiliate, the NJ FFA Alumni will provide one FREE student state convention registration. In the end, a chapter that participates in this level will receive three student state convention registrations (one from the Golf Tournament sponsorship and one from the Alumni in level 1 and one for chartering/reactivating an Alumni Affiliate).
