MARCH 1, 2021

MARCH 15, 2021

- American FFA Degree Applications Due

MAY 1, 2021

- Email "What do you hope to accomplish as a national officer?" essay (1,000 words or less) and SAE program description per year (200 characters or less per year) Office of Food, Agriculture & Natural Resources Education at ag.ed.registration@ag.nj.gov.

MAY 17, 2021

- Submit Introduction of New Jersey's National Officer Candidate(s) for Convention Session IV

JUNE 1, 2021

- Email completed National Officer Candidate Development Form to Office of Food, Agriculture & Natural Resources Education at ag.ed.registration@ag.nj.gov. This form can be found on the State Activity Guide.

JUNE 9, 2021 (Tentative)

- National Officer Candidate Selection Process

9:00 am – 5:00 pm (all phases of the process will be evaluated)
